Ricky's love of his family, and his nephews, along with the devotion and kindness he shared with his friends and teammates, are some of the things people remember most about him.

Ricky went to school on May 26, 2006 like every other day. On his way out to recess that afternoon, Ricky was running from the school to the playground when he collapsed. Every effort was made to revive Ricky, but they were unsuccessful. The cause could not be determined, but it was suggested that it was something with his heart. The medical examiner also said that he could not believe the shape Ricky was in. In his words "He was a rock, and the best shaped 13-year-old young man I ever examined."

Ricky was extremely athletic and loved many sports--basketball, golf, bike riding, swimming to name just a few--but his true love was football. Ricky was a gifted quarterback and led his team to the 2005 NH State Championship. That year, with the help of all of his teammates, Ricky passed for almost 1000 yards. Ricky's coaches often marveled at the type of player Ricky was, and how talented he was. Ricky was a very humble young man and was never full of himself.

The scholarship fund was set up to provide the youth of the local area with academic and athletic scholarships. It is our hope to give scholarships to local schools and also to support student athletes in the area. Some of our athletic scholarships may send children to a football camp. Something Ricky loved to attend.
